

PRIVACY NOTICE FOR TAKING PICTURES AND MAKING VIDEO RECORDINGS

During the making and use of the sound and image recordings – including video recordings in particular – (hereinafter: **‘Recording’**) prepared by SZIGET in accordance with Clause III. 4.2. of the General Terms and Conditions laying down the rights and obligations concerning ticket purchases and the purchase of other products and services regarding all festivals organised and hosted by SZIGET Kulturális Menedzser Iroda Zártkörűen Működő Részvénytársaság (Sziget Cultural Management Private Company Limited by Shares) (hereinafter individually as the **‘Event’** and jointly as the **‘Events’**), regulating the legal relationship between Sziget and ticket purchasers, as well as laying down the general terms and conditions of the visitors’ participation at the Events (hereinafter: **‘GTC’**), the personal data of the data subjects will be processed as follows (in the cases where the data subject is recognisable in the image and sound recordings), in which cases data will be processed under Act CXII of 2011 on Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information, Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: **‘GDPR’**) and Act V of 2013 on the Civil Code of Hungary (hereinafter: **‘Civil Code’**). In compliance with the provisions of the laws referred to above, SZIGET hereby informs the data subjects of the details of the processing of their personal data, along with the rights they have in this regard.

SZIGET shall determine the categories of the data processed during the making and use of the Recordings, as well as the purpose, duration, legal basis and other substantial conditions of processing. SZIGET hereby informs the data subjects that it may also permit third parties to make Recordings at the Events; however, in such cases SZIGET processes no personal data, and such third party shall qualify as the controller, who will process the personal data of the data subjects pursuant to its own privacy policy.

The Recordings may be prepared and used with regard to the undertaking in Clause III. 4.2. of the GTC.

Data processing, persons with access to the personal data, data transmission:

Data may be accessed by the employees of SZIGET working in the marketing area and/or the Processors named below to carry out their tasks. Thus, for example, the system administrator of SZIGET and the Processors named in this Notice may access the personal data for the purposes of administration and data processing.

To perform its activities, SZIGET uses as Processors all the providers that make the Recordings of the data subjects.

For the storage of the personal data, SZIGET uses the operational services offered by Netpositive Kft., which stores the data at the GTS Datanet server room located at Budapest, XIII. ker. Victor Hugo u. 18-22, Hungary.

Moreover, SZIGET also uses the services of the Hidden Design Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (1095 Budapest, Gát utca 21. fszt. 1., Company register No.: 01-09-278702, tax number: 23089655-2-43) to provide a runtime environment for the Websites of SZIGET. The Hidden Design Kft. resorts to the following sub-processors (the data are exclusively stored at servers located in the European Union): the Contabo GmbH (Aschauer Straße 32a, 81549 Munich, Germany, Company registration number: HRB 180722, registry court: AG München, tax number: DE267602842, telephone number: +49 89 3564717 70, Fax: +49 89 216 658 62, e-mail: info@contabo.com), and the DigitalOcean LLC (101 Avenue of the Americas, 10th Floor, New York, NY 10013, United States).

SZIGET is entitled to transfer the recordings to its sponsors. The list of sponsors are available at the webpages of the Events.

Use of the Recordings, publication of the Films

The personal data contained in the Recordings will only be processed in the context of making and publishing the Films as specified in this document. No Film may be produced and published unless it features the data subjects in situations, contexts and while engaging in conducts that are generally foreseeable for the data subjects in relation to their participation at the Event in question, on the understanding that recordings generally harmful for the data subject and obviously prejudicial to SZIGET will not be used. Certain parts, elements (including images and sound recordings separately) of the Films created and published earlier may be used in further films. The Recordings used in the

Films may be modified for the following reasons and in the following ways, at the good faith discretion of SZIGET not adversely affecting the data subjects' interests:

- the sharpness and colour depth of the recorded image, for aesthetic reasons;
- to blur out any brand logo or reference to an undertaking other than SZIGET appearing in the Recording;
- to blur out any offensive content.

In accordance with the practice followed by SZIGET at the time of the publication of this document, the Films may be published in the following ways:

- the Events, or the advertisements used by SZIGET from time to time, which are broadcasted in television channels or in cinemas;
- in the online space available to SZIGET.

Data security

Your rights concerning the data processing

The data subject may request information about data processing, may request access to the personal data (may obtain from the Controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed, and if so, what kind of data processing is in progress). SZIGET shall provide the requested information and notification free of charge. Where requests from a data subject are manifestly unfounded or excessive, in particular because of their repetitive character, SZIGET may either charge a reasonable fee taking into account the administrative costs of providing the information or communication or taking the action requested, or refuse to act on the request.

SZIGET shall provide information on action taken on a request to the data subject without undue delay and in any event within one month (30 days) of receipt of the request. That period may be extended by two further months where necessary, taking into account the complexity and number of the requests. SZIGET shall inform the data subject of any such extension within one month of receipt of the request, together with the reasons for the delay. Where the data subject makes the request by electronic form means, the information shall be provided by electronic means where possible, unless otherwise requested by the data subject

The right to rectification can not be exercised or can be exercised limited, concerning the nature of the processed data. The data subject – pursuant to Article 17. and 18. of the GDPR – has the right to request from SZIGET the erasure of personal data or restriction of processing of personal data.

Legal remedies

If you feel that the Controller has violated any of the legal provisions applicable to data processing, please contact us first by sending an email to the data protection officer's email address: dpo@sziget.hu, or by sending a letter to SZIGET's seat.

If this proves to be unsuccessful, you may initiate a proceeding with the National Data Protection and Freedom on Information Authority (Nemzeti Adatvédelmi és Információszabadság Hatóság, NAIH, mailing address: H-1125 Budapest, Szilágyi Erzsébet fasor 22/c., email: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu) or seek judicial remedy. Decision of the case is within the jurisdiction of the superior court. Legal proceedings – at the choice of the data subject - may also be brought before the superior court where the data subject has domicile or residence.
